## Entry Checklist

- CD (**no slides** will be accepted)
- SASE (self-addressed stamped envelope)  
If you do not want your CD returned then only submit enough postage for the return of your entry form

## Guidelines

All work must be for sale. A commission of 40% will be taken on all works sold as a result of this exhibition. Payment will be mailed to the artist within 30 days of the exhibition closing. Works are insured while in Target Gallery. Artists are required to sign a Loan Agreement and a Terms & Condition Agreement if accepted. The Target Gallery will keep the CD images of accepted works and reserves the right to reproduce the images for all media and publicity purposes.

## Delivery

The artist is required to bring all necessary equipment and materials to gallery by Tuesday, July 22 at the latest. Any special needs must be addressed with advance notice to the TG Director to insure that the artist is ready to begin installation on Wednesday, July 23 at 12:00pm. At the completion of the exhibition the artist is required to either return to de-install exhibition or make prior arrangements with the gallery. **If the artist chooses to have the work shipped back to them, then return shipping must be prepaid and enclosed with artwork.** Neither Target Gallery nor the Torpedo Factory Art Center will be responsible for any damage incurred in transit.

## Limitations

All entries must have been conceived and created by the artist submitting the work. The chosen artist is required to work within the dimensions of the gallery and during gallery hours. The artist is also required to provide any special needs to the TG Director in advance notice of the installation project. The gallery reserves the right to reject work that differs from the chosen proposal and/or submitted images.

## Application

The application materials must be received in the Target Gallery no later than **5 pm on Monday, May 5, 2008.**

## Juror: Dale Ihnken

Our juror is Executive Director of the Hamiltonian Artists in Washington, DC, Dale Ihnken. Ihnken's organization is designed to help promote emerging artists. He is also a Professor of Art with George Mason University. Ihnken studied at Bradley University and Maryland Institute College of Art and received his MFA from Pratt Institute College of Art.

## About the Gallery

The Target Gallery, the national exhibition space of the Torpedo Factory Art Center, is run by the Torpedo Factory Artists' Association. Artists on the Target Gallery Committee are responsible for the planning of exhibitions and overall mission of the gallery. The Target Gallery promotes high standards of art by continuously exploring new ideas through visual media in a schedule of national and international exhibitions. The gallery hosts nine exhibits annually--some juried, some curated--featuring a variety of themes and artists. In an effort to keep our perspective challenged, our exhibits are usually composed of artists outside of the Torpedo Factory and represent artistic views from across the nation.

The Target Gallery is open to the public Wednesday through Sunday from noon to 5pm, and every second Thursday of the month until 9pm as a part of Old Town Alexandria's Second Thursday Art Night.

## Directions For Entry

1. Image entry will be PC compatible JPEG digital files only. **We regret that we cannot review images via email or 35mm slides.** Images of up to three works (also referred to as entries) may be submitted. Only five detail images per entry may be included with each application having up to three entries permitted. CDs must contain the artist's name on both the actual CD and the case. JPEGs should be no larger than 300 dpi at approximately 4 by 6 inches. All digital files must be in JPEG format and must include the artist's name and title of the submission (smithpainting5.jpg). Please do not use quotations, periods, or spaces in file names. Video and time-based submissions should be both PC and Macintosh compatible. Submissions must be able to play in standard media viewing programs such as DVD, QuickTime, or Windows Media players (.MOV files are preferred). You may NOT submit VHS tapes. **Website links will not be accepted as submissions.**
2. Include a self-addressed stamped envelope (SASE) with sufficient postage for the return of CDs or enough for return of notification.
3. A non-refundable fee of \$35.00 must accompany each entry form. Checks are to be made payable to the Torpedo Factory Artists' Association (TFAA). The gallery will accept Paypal payment on a case by case basis. Please contact the gallery directly if you wish to pay this way.
4. The entry form must be complete and include all requested information. Incomplete applications are subject to disqualification.
